What Will We Do?

EDC and partners will run 12-month [Collaborative Improvement and Innovation Networks](#) (CoIINs) for each of the three initial topics. MIECHV Awardees and local implementing agencies (LIAs) can choose to join one of the three topic CoIINs.

What is a CoIIN?

A CoIIN brings together MIECHV awardees and LIAs around a common aim to share valuable information, network, and collaborate meaningfully using continuous quality improvement (CQI.) This **voluntary experience** offers free expert improvement coaching, tools, and resources to help home visiting programs implement well-tested interventions to address service gaps swiftly and effectively.

Why Join Now?

- **Center health equity!** All teams will receive guidance on building diverse CQI teams and creating community histories that facilitate a shared understanding of the root causes of inequities. Additional opportunities for developing SMARTIE (**S**trategic, **M**easurable, **A**mbitious, **R**ealistic, **T**ime-bound, **I**nclusive, **E**quitable) aims and analyzing stratified data will also be offered
- **Learn from your peers!** We will offer a CQI Lead Community of Practice (CoP) to build peer connections and facilitate awardee work with LIAs
- Access **streamlined, well-tested interventions** that are most useful to get what works to more people in less time.
- Orient new staff, [build capacity](#) to engage in CQI at awardee and LIA levels and learn strategies for **retaining the workforce**.
- Fulfill **MIECHV CQI Plan** requirements
- **Gain access to a specialized team** of improvement advisors, expert topic faculty, experienced parent leaders, and equity coaches ready to support you every step of the way.
- **Multilingual support** from project staff, expert topic faculty, and CQI improvement advisors with real-time Spanish interpretation during calls.
- **Training in evidence-based practices** that lead to breakthrough change, like, [Mothers & Babies](#)

Who Can Apply?

- All state and territory MIECHV awardees and their selected LIAs interested in improving program outcomes in one of the available topics (caregiver depression, staff recruitment and retention, and health equity).
- A MIECHV awardee lead should complete the application on behalf of their state or territory team.

Timeline:

- **Applications due by Nov 30, 2022**
 - Applications should take about 10-15 minutes to complete.
 - **After** submitting the application, Awardees should **sign up [here](#) for a 20–30-minute call** to discuss participation and your unique needs for success.
- **Awardee** participation will kick off with an orientation call on December 15 2022; the preparatory period for awardees will continue through March 2023.
- **LIA** participation begins April 2023 and concludes April 2024.
