The following is intended to be universal rights that all family visiting participants can expect to receive:

I have a right to...

- Stop family visiting services at any moment - Family Visiting is voluntary!
- Access to services in my preferred language.
- Receive care from providers who respect my cultural background
- Be seen and heard
- Be respected by those who provide family visiting services to my family and me
- Decide the services and care my family and I receive
- Receive care that acknowledges my strengths and builds upon them
- Set my goals for myself, my family, and my children and to receive information and resources to help me reach my goals.
- Choose the family and friends that are present during my family visiting services
- Be free of discrimination based on my race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, disability, HIV status, immigration status, housing status, income level, or form of insurance
