

HV CollN Change Champions Series Every Family Thrives

Are you looking for new ways of approaching quality improvement work to achieve healthy outcomes for every family? Join us for a three-month improvement network beginning October X, 2024!

Every Family Thrives is a new and creative professional development series from HV CoIIN that will introduce awardees and LIAs to key concepts for advancing their continuous quality improvement (CQI) efforts with an eye toward equity and ensuring that every home visiting family reaches their highest potential. Core content will include: elevating parent leaders in CQI, grounding CQI efforts in community and program histories, disaggregating data to identify gaps and work to improve outcomes for every family, and preparing teams to adapt and test changes for relevant community and family contexts.

Participants will:

- Join **six**, **90-minute group calls** to learn key concepts and practice applying to their own CQI processes and work.
- Calls will be structured to allow for content teaching, peer sharing, and work time to minimize burden between calls.
- Content will support participants to plan for future awardee-led or HV CollN COI projects.

All MIECHV awardees with an interest in exploring how family leadership, community histories, and stratified data can enhance your CQI work are encouraged to apply. This opportunity might also appeal to those interested in engaging with HV CoIIN to plan for centering equity in a future CQI project of your choosing. Awardees are invited to apply with one interested LIA.
