

HV CollN Change Champions Series Sprint to Sustain Improvement in Intimate Partner Violence

Are you looking for actionable tips, tools, and resources to support conversations with caregivers about healthy and unhealthy relationships? Join us for a four-month improvement sprint beginning September 12, 2024!

An improvement sprint is a simple way to learn new skills, introduce changes, and amplify impact by applying concentrated effort to generate improvement over a short period of time. Sprint to Sustain Improvement in Intimate Partner Violence brings together MIECHV awardees and LIAs with expert faculty from Futures Without Violence for a limited time to support the rapid testing and implementation of universal education on healthy and unhealthy relationships.

Participating teams will:

- Form an improvement team and work together with national experts, HV CollN staff, and peers across the country to address intimate partner violence in home visiting.
- Join **four, 90-minute group calls** to learn about "Connected Parent, Connected Kids" cards and connect with other LIAs.
- Participate in **three**, **60-minute coaching calls** to plan and review PDSA cycles and adapt testing to your program's specific context (e.g., rural communities, cultural contexts, multiple languages).
- Submit PDSAs and data every other week. LIAs will collect and report on one measure throughout the sprint.

All MIECHV awardees and LIAs with an interest in building processes to support universal education on healthy and unhealthy relationships are encouraged to apply. This opportunity might appeal to teams interested in concentrating their CQI efforts on a small set of changes over a short period of time. It would also be a good fit for teams interested in learning more about resources to support conversations about intimate partner violence and those working with communities and populations disproportionately affected by IPV. Awardees are invited to apply with up to four LIAs.
